Meeting Minutes by Deb Stoflet — February 3, 2020

Roll Call:

Old Business:

Park Shelterhouse Chair Replacement — Stoflet brought in 3 samples of chairs from Book & Stationary in Marshfield. The board thought the 3 bared metal chairs were the best. The Lions will review them at their next meeting. Stoflet will see what she can get for the old chairs and we will review this at the next meeting and see what the village needs to come up with for the replacement of 200 chairs.

New Business:

Ordinance Officer Report —

Gonzalez was present. He stated he was on the job for 6 months and gave a short review. He enjoys his job with the village and would like to continue. The board is very satisfied with the job he has been doing. He is okay with the pay he is getting.

Gonzalez passed out a monthly law report for us to review.

Park Playground Lighting-

We discussed that the playground at the park needs additional lighting. Last year a child ran into one of the bars on the playground and an ambulance had to be called. Wood County officers also had a concern regarding the dark area. Spatz will talk to Draxler regarding mounting additional lighting on a parking lot pole. Extra lighting might need to be rented for the Music Fest event. We will review at the next meeting.

Some patching has been done on some of the village streets.

Spatz will be working with the high school regarding some of their roof drains and water issues.

Spatz will check the tunnel regarding possible water build up.

Spatz stated snow groomers need to be more careful keeping piles of snow off the roads.
